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By registering to attend VERTICON 2025, an event produced by Vertical Aviation International (VAI) to be held in the city of Dallas, Texas, at the Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center Dallas (KBHCCD), the attendee agrees to comply with the following VERTICON 2025 Attendee Terms and Conditions (henceforth the "Terms and Conditions").

Badges and Show-Floor Access

Attendee badges are required to access the exhibit hall during VERTICON. VERTICON attendee badges are for use by one individual for the duration of the show and are nontransferable after use or after Thursday, Mar. 13, 2025.

Child Attendee Policy

All children (anyone under 18) must be accompanied by an adult. Registration for children ages 14 and under is free. However, children ages 14 and under must wear a youth badge, which can be picked up in Attendee Registration. Children ages 15 to 17 must obtain a paid registration to attend. Student rates are available for qualifying attendees.

Drone Policy

All drones that will be brought onto KBHCCD premises during VERTICON 2025 must be approved by VAI in writing prior to arriving on-site. Drones by law must be registered with the FAA, have a trained operator, and must remain within the operator's view while in operation. Operating drones in any exterior areas of the KBHCCD is explicitly prohibited under the FAA restricted airspace regulation.

Cancellation Policy

Registrants should email Verticon@verticalavi.org by midnight Fri., Feb. 21, 2025, if they need to cancel their VERTICON registration. Registrants who cancel their registration by this deadline will receive a refund in the amount of the registration fee paid less a \$20 processing fee. VAI will accept changes to attendee registrations, such as the name on the registration or the dates attending; however, no changes will be accepted after Mar. 13, 2025, or once the badge is used.

Health & Safety and Risk Acknowledgment

VAI is committed to the health and safety of our attendees, exhibitors, speakers, partners, and staff. VAI will operate VERTICON in accordance with official federal, state government, and local authority rules, following US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines and any additional venue or location-specific rules designed to mitigate the spread and contraction of COVID-19. By registering and attending VERTICON, the attendee agrees to voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure and agrees not to hold VAI, VERTICON, or any of their affiliates, including partners and sponsors, directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, volunteers, or sponsored venues, liable for illness. In addition to following all social distancing requirements and other protocols and requests of VAI and the KBHCCD with regard to COVID-19 mitigation while on the premises and at VERTICON, registrants agree they will not attend any VAI or VERTICON event if they feel ill, have COVID-19, or suspect they have been recently exposed to COVID-19.

Food and Beverages

Attendees shall not bring into the KBHCCD any food, whether prepared or unprepared, or beverages of any kind whatsoever, including but not limited to alcoholic beverages.

Animals

Attendees shall not bring any animals, other than service animals, onto KBHCCD premises.

Fire Regulations

Smoking is not permitted inside the venue meeting rooms, public areas (e.g., restrooms, concourses, etc.), or exhibit hall at any time. All emergency exits, hallways, sidewalks, ramps, driveways, public utility access points, and aisles must be kept clear and unobstructed. The doors, skylights,

stairways, or openings that reflect or admit light into any place in the building, including hallways, fire hose cabinets, and housing lighting equipment, must not be covered or obstructed.

Limitation of Liability

ATTENDEE AGREES TO ASSUME ALL RISK AND LIABILITY AND TO HOLD HARMLESS VAI, THE CITY OF DALLAS, THE KAY BAILEY HUTCHISON CONVENTION CENTER DALLAS, AND THEIR OFFICIALS, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, MEMBERS, AFFILIATES, AGENTS, SERVANTS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES, CONTRACTORS, SUBCONTRACTORS, AND CONSULTANTS FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, INJURY, DEFENSE COSTS, LIABILITIES, JUDGMENTS, LOSS, EXPENSES, OR DAMAGES OF ANY KIND OR NATURE ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH:

(A) DAMAGE, FIRE DAMAGE, THEFT, DESTRUCTION, OR LOSS OF ANY PROPERTY BELONGING TO OR IN THE POSSESSION OR CONTROL OF THE ATTENDEE OR BELONGING TO VAI, THE CITY OF DALLAS, OR THE KAY BAILEY HUTCHISON CONVENTION CENTER, AND/OR

(B) ANY INJURY (INCLUDING BODILY INJURY OR DEATH) TO ATTENDEE, RELATING TO, ARISING OUT OF, CAUSED BY, OCCASIONED BY, OR IN CONNECTION WITH (1) THE ATTENDEE'S PARTICIPATION IN OR PRESENCE AT VERTICON 2025; (2) ANY ACT OR OMISSION OF THE ATTENDEE; OR (3) THE ATTENDEE'S BREACH OF ANY OF THE TERMS OR PROVISIONS OF THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

Enforcement of Rules

VAI has full power of interpretation and enforcement of these Terms and Conditions. Attendees who fail to comply with federal, state, and local laws or ordinances, or who fail to observe these Terms and Conditions, or who, at VAI's sole discretion, conduct themselves in a manner inconsistent with the rights of other attendees or exhibitors, or who act in an unprofessional manner or in a manner unfavorable to the image of VAI may be removed from VERTICON without refund or other appeal and may be barred from future VAI trade shows and exhibitions. This includes persons, things, printed matter, or anything that might

be objectionable to VAI. Additionally, VAI and the KBHCCD retain the right to remove from the premises any and all disorderly attendees and the right to eject any disorderly person or persons from the KBHCCD or any of its facilities, including the right to remove and eject persons who refuse to comply with health and safety requirements. In the event of the exercise of this authority, the attendee waives any and all claims for damages against VAI and the KBHCCD on account thereof.

Force Majeure

VERTICON 2025 may be postponed or canceled due to an uncontrollable event, including but not limited to fire, flood, earthquake, hurricane, storm, drought, other extreme catastrophes or weather conditions; strike, lockout, or industrial action; failure of or threat of failure of facilities, equipment, mechanical, or utilities; national emergency, global health crisis, epidemic, riots, terrorism, threats of terrorism, war, material or labor restrictions by any governmental authority, unavoidable casualty, acts of God, severe curtailment of national transportation that represents a clear and adverse effect on the ability of at least 40% of any documented pre-registered attendees to attend the event, governmental directive that would prohibit aircraft being flown into the city of Dallas or onto the KBHCCD premises, unavailability of the KBHCCD premises, or any other circumstances or events beyond the control of VAI. If VERTICON 2025 is canceled for any reason set forth in this section, VAI may return a portion of the attendee's registration fee(s), but in no event shall the amount returned to the attendee exceed the total registration fee(s) amount already paid by the attendee to VAI. Except as provided in this section, VAI shall not, as a consequence of VERTICON 2025 being postponed or canceled, be responsible for any cost, damage, expenses, or loss of revenue that may be incurred by the attendee. Additionally, in the event that VERTICON 2025 is not postponed or canceled but government regulations related to the COVID-19 pandemic (such as a travel ban) would nevertheless prevent an attendee from participating in VERTICON or would result in substantial unanticipated costs to the attendee, and the attendee provides VAI with sufficient written documentation of such regulations and costs, VAI will allow the attendee to cancel for a full refund.
